







## Administrative Council Highlights – November 17, 2020

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, November 17, 2020 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Church Re-Opening.** With Merced County now in the Purple tier, indoor worship services are again prohibited. An option is outdoor services, but with upcoming cold weather, we will go back to recorded services. The NA and AA groups want to keep meeting indoors in small numbers, which the District Superintendent has okayed if they get an exemption letter from the County Health Department. We have been assured that there will be only 10 to 13 at their meetings, and they have been trained on proper cleaning of the sites, using their own cleaning supplies.

We have tried to livestream Sunday services a few times, but only succeeded once, due to Internet issues. Jim and Cassie have checked into two other Internet service providers, to improve on our 25 Mbps current DSL service through AT&T, which costs about \$160 per month and also includes two telephone lines. Xfinity has many options, and the package that seems most applicable to us would cost about \$200 per month with a download speed of 300 Mbps, but just one phone line. One other provider was contacted, but it would include no telephone service and uses radio waves, requiring us to erect one or two antennas. There was some question as to whether 300 Mbps would be fast enough for our needs, and after some discussion, staff was authorized to deal with Xfinity and commit to up to \$250 per month for the best package available to meet the church's needs.

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The NOW team met by Zoom, talking first about our return to the Purple tier, prohibiting indoor worship. All agreed we should not meet outside, but again videotape weekly services. Tawny and Shannan are planning a taped Christmas pageant featuring our Sunday school children, hopefully along with the kids from Dos Palos. The Dos Palos church is making Christmas baskets, including Christian books, for their children.

The Nazarene Church is now helping with Manna. NOW will not meet in December. Christmas Eve services were discussed. Cassie is to canvas the congregation to see how many might go to an outdoor candlelight service if we are still in the Purple tier. Regardless, a livestream and/or taped service should be produced and posted. We will also give people a chance to “purchase” virtual poinsettias, like we did for the Easter lilies, to raise money for our Conference obligations.

- **Trustees.** The Sloan family has agreed to finance almost the whole cost to refurbish the pews in Bill's memory. The Council talked about maybe buying 200 chairs instead, for about the same cost, to provide more flexibility in the use of the sanctuary. There was no consensus as to which way to proceed, but it was agreed to pursue the chair concept only if the Sloan family was in support.
- **UMW.** There was no news to report, and it is uncertain about the annual UMW Christmas party. Jim offered to help set up Zoom meetings, if so desired.
- **Financial Report.** October collections were \$10,712.82; paid expenses were \$10,641.47. The October 31 checkbook balance was \$8,668.25, and all of the church's October bills were paid up to date, except for a \$1,000.00 tithe payment to the Conference.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** The SPRC met by Zoom in November to work on some end-of-year reporting that needs to be submitted to the Conference.
- **2020 Charge Conference.** Our combined Charge Conference with the Dos Palos church was held as a Zoom meeting on October 31. Jim has discovered that the membership report needs to be corrected, so the minutes will be revised before they are forwarded on.
- **Next Meeting of Administrative Council.** The December meeting was cancelled, so the next meeting will be January 5, 2021.
- **People in Need; Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Cathie Lopez, Tom Shepherd, Kathy Garrison and Dan Bonillas.

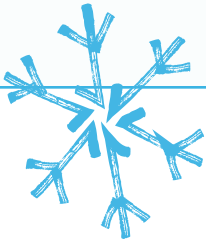


### ***SCRIP TIP OF THE MONTH***
